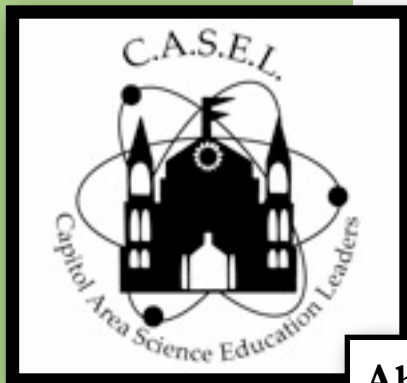

such as energy balance and calorie intake and incorporate lessons on the brain with easy to do, exciting activities.

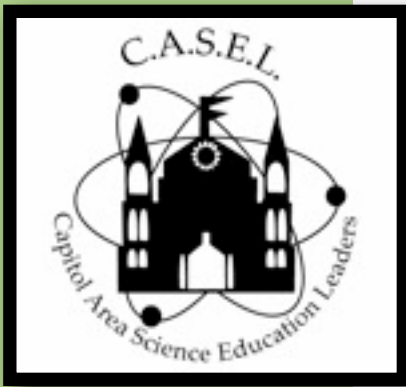
