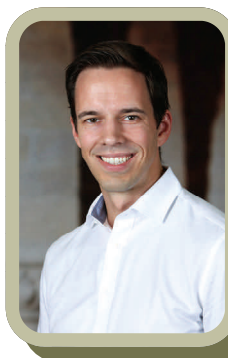

Dan Meyer advocates for better math instruction and has appeared on CNN, Good Morning America, Everyday With Rachel Ray, and TED.com. He was named one of Tech & Learning's 30 Leaders of the Future and is an Apple Distinguished Educator.



Dr. Meyer earned his doctorate from Stanford University, has been a classroom teacher, is an International speaker, and is currently the Chief Academic Officer at Desmos, a company committed to helping move education's print past into its digital future.

As a self described "worker, learner, go-getter, writer, and speaker," Dr. Meyer's perspective on curriculum design, teacher education, and teacher retention is informed by tech trends and online discourse as much as front-line experience with students.
