- Program began in 1998 at Satellite City Hall in Sherwood Mall under the name of Math Smart Tutoring.
- Moved due to closure of Satellite City Hall in 2002 to Margaret K. Troke Library.
- Program Overview:
 - Free drop-in tutoring.
 - Serving 6th – 12th grade students from any public or private school in Stockton area.
 - Tutors are volunteers, experienced math enthusiasts from a variety of backgrounds.
 - Teachers and retired teachers, engineers, retired physicist, university students, advanced high school students, and others.
- Students come from many public schools as well as private, parochial and charter schools.
