Prerequisites for Participating Schools/Districts:

- Completion of RSDSS Region 6 Direct Instruction Institutes – Year 1 and Year 2
- Current instructional coach, certified by RSDSS 6 at both the Classroom and Coach Level, **or** a RSDSS 6 Classroom Level certified “coach designee” working towards Coach Certification
- Structured and guaranteed time for the coach (or coach designee) to work with other teachers

Must register for **either** Site-Based Technical Assistance or District Capacity Building, **and** RSDSS, Region 6 Coach Network.

Registration required to be eligible for RSDSS Certifications.

 - 3 Coach Level Certification observations
 - 6 hours of Site Capacity-Building (may be broken into two 3-hour sessions)
