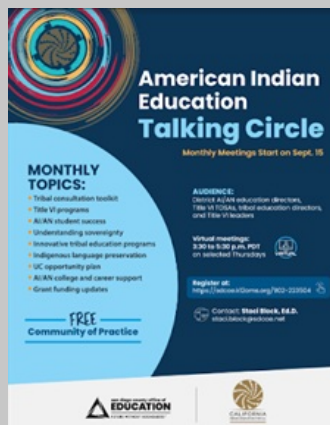

November is Native American Heritage Month



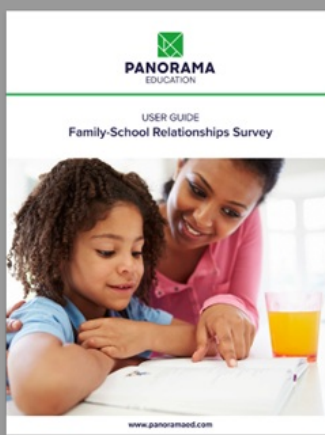
