Workshop Description

"See the Sound with Visual Phonics" is a system of moving hand shapes that look and feel like the sounds they represent. This system also utilizes written symbols that are a visual representation of the hand shape. Unlike other cueing systems, Visual Phonics cues are suggestive of the manner of speech production; it is not based on orthography or other random movements. The system was developed by The International Communication Learning Institute (I.C.L.I.) located in Minnesota. Further developments and improvements to this system continue to be made by I.C.L.I. Visual Phonics has been effective working with children and adults who do not learn readily from traditional approaches.

Learner Outcomes

Participants will:

- Describe and discuss the use of Visual Phonics to a parent/spouse.
- Learn all of the hand cues and written symbols for each sound.
- Cue a short paragraph using blending and positional cues.
- Learn how to use the program with a variety of individuals in conjunction with materials that are already in use.
- Learn how to use the system in general to assist in decoding for reading.
- Learn some activities to use with Visual Phonics.
