#2 Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA)

When, why and how to complete an FBA, including the legal requirements of Ed code. Participants will also learn about pathway charting, be given examples of data collection, and other strategies to determine the function of behaviors. Participants will work through a case study. This intermediate workshop is targeted for educator's who may need to write FBA's or just want to know more about the process. #4—Positive Behavior Strategies and Plan Implementation

This intermediate session includes implementation of positive behavior strategies that are included in BIP's as well as tips on how to coach staff (teachers, paraeducators etc.). Participants will learn how to avoid common mistakes and pitfalls in the behavior change process.
