Research has shown that use of Assistive Technology can support individuals with autism spectrum disorders. Assistive Technology is defined as: "Any item, piece of equipment or product system acquired commercially off-the-shelf, modified or customized that is used to increase, maintain or improve functional capabilities of individuals with disabilities." When addressing AT needs, the assessment process includes a feature match to student needs. Assistive Technology assists students with autism spectrum disorders to process information through their stronger learning modality. This training will discuss a variety of Assistive Technology tools that can support individuals with an autism spectrum disorder.

- Identify student characteristics/needs that can be addressed through Assistive Technology
- List assistive technology tools to support students with an Autism Spectrum Disorder
- Organize AT into core areas to support every aspect of daily living in order to improve the functional capabilities of individuals with autism.
