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SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY FIRST TO PILOT FLOORMASTERS APPRENTICE PROGRAM

WHAT: A Graduation for the first cohort of Floormasters apprentices, where they will receive

an industry recognized certificate in flooring instillation from Armstrong Floors. The graduates will be hired as installer helpers by Floormasters, with the opportunity to

advance to installer.

BACKGROUND: Floormasters, Inc. launched a new training program for job seekers throughout

Northern California in partnership with San Joaquin County Office of Education, Human Service Agency, Housing Authority of San Joaquin, Habitat for Humanity of San Joaquin, California Human Development, San Joaquin County WorkNet, Visionary Homebuilders,

and YouthBuild San Joaquin.

The first training session consisted of three weeks of apprentice-level training for installing both hard-surface flooring and carpet. During the first and second weeks, students used mockups to prepare and install sheet vinyl for bathrooms and install carpet. Trainees helped install carpet and vinyl at the Grant Village Apartment

Complex.

Qualified participants will be eligible for full-time installer positions with the Floormasters team in Hayward, Peninsula, North Bay, Tri-County, East Bay, San Francisco, Greater Sacramento as well as Napa, Yolo, El Dorado, San Joaquin and Stanislaus Counties. The training program was led by Floormasters at no cost to participants or the partner organizations. All materials were donated by Floormasters'



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partners, including Armstrong, Bigelow, De Soto Diamond W, Engineered Floors, Gallaher, Leggett and Platt, Mannington, Mohawk, Osborne Lumber and Patcraft.



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DETAILS ABOUT THE FLOORMASTERS INSTALLER TRAINING PROGRAM:

The Floormasters Installer Training Program will consist of classroom instruction for two weeks followed by hands-on training the third week. Participants will work on installations at five units for an affordable housing non-profit organization, Visionary Home Builders. Training will focus on core competencies and best practices for flooring installation, including:

Apprentice-level hard surface installation training for vinyl and VTC tile:

- Material handling
- Proper lifting techniques
- · Demolition of existing floor coverings
- Surface preparation
- Underlayment installation
- Measuring
- Flooring materials layout
- Cutting
- Adhesive application
- Installation
- Sundries application cove base, cove base adhesives and terminations (transitions, moldings and metals)

Apprentice-level carpet installation training:

- Material handling
- Proper lifting techniques
- Surface preparation
- Measuring
- Carpet seam layout
- Cutting
- Seaming
- Stretching
- Cove base installation
- Wood base removal and replacement
- Terminations (metals)
